Materials:

- Four 1-gallon jugs
- One half-gallon jug
- X-Acto knife
- Marker
- Glue gun
- White spray paint
- Black and pink acrylic paint



Directions:

1. Use an X-Acto knife to cut the legs from four 1-gallon milk jugs (see A). Cut two with larger diameters (muscle mass) for the hind legs and with two slightly smaller diameters (front legs).
2. To make the body, cut the handle off of a half-gallon jug (see B).
3. With the jug handle area of the body jug facing down, use hot glue (a parent's job) to attach the legs (see C).
